The QRA 2 (Quantitative Risk Assessment) maximum safe use concentrations have been developed from toxicological information available on fragrance ingredients and have taken into consideration the aggregate exposure from cosmetic, household and other fragranced consumer products.

For Takasago proprietary materials or supplier materials that do not have IFRA standards, either assessments have been conducted by an internal expert following the guidelines established by RIFM and the maximum use concentration has been established utilizing the QRA2 methodology or provided limits have been reviewed by internal experts prior to application of maximum use concentrations.
